# Categories of Exchange Program

The IAAS Exchange Program is structured into two main categories in order to accommodate different academic needs, availability, and career goals of students.

**The first category is the Short-Term Training Program,** which is designed for a duration of approximately 10 days. This program is ideal for students who wish to gain international exposure, participate in specialized training, attend workshops, or experience academic and professional environments abroad within a limited time frame. It focuses on skill development, institutional visits, cultural exchange, and introductory professional learning.

**The second category is the Long-Term Internship Program,** which has a duration of approximately three months. This program is intended for students who seek in-depth professional experience in their field of study. Participants work as interns in universities, research centers, NGOs, or private organizations, gaining practical knowledge, professional competencies, and a deeper understanding of international work culture.

Both categories aim to enhance students' academic growth, professional readiness, and intercultural understanding, while supporting the overall mission of IAAS to develop globally competent and socially responsible young professionals.

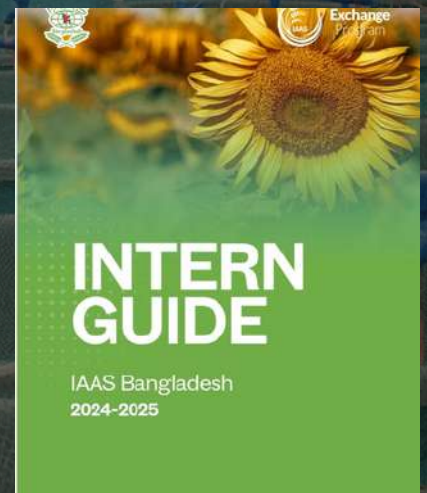
